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LIEPAJA – the city of culture, art and music. Liepaja is rich in well-established cultural traditions. It is the home of the oldest professional Latvian theatre, the only professional symphony orchestra outside Riga, a puppet theatre, a number of folklore groups and numerous choirs.

There are also different art exhibitions arranged in Liepaja, young artists grow in art schools and art plener takes place in the city in summers.

Through the time Liepaja had a fame of musical city. There is the largest mechanical organ in the world in Liepaja's St. Trinity Cathedral. Different concerts take place in the cathedral and international festival of organ music has become as a tradition. Use the opportunity to climb up to the top of the church tower revealing a breathtaking panorama of Liepaja! The city is famous for its variety of musical events, such as the Piano Festival in the spring, various music festivals in the summer, international festival of organ music in the autumn.

The Latvian Musicians Alley of Fame is located in Liepaja. There are plaques with handprints of musicians and plaques honouring current and former music bands in the Alley. Another sight of interest here is the largest Guitar in Latvia.



LIEPAJA - the city where the great old buildings coexist with modern architecture. Rose Square is the heart of Liepaja where both historical and modern live together. There are buildings built in 18th century and also recently built. Also there are about 70 buildings belonging to Art Nouveau and many old buildings have gained a contemporary look.



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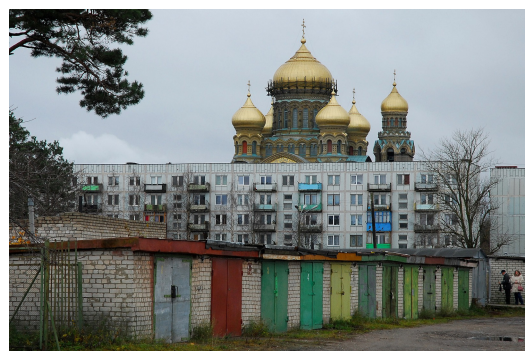

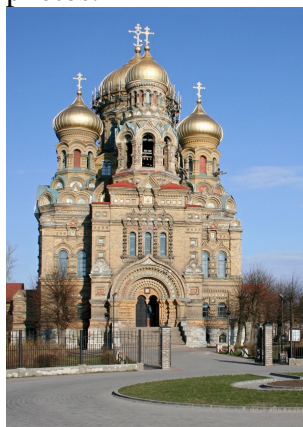


KAROSTA (The Naval Port) – the town in the city. Karosta was built in the end of 19th and beginning of 20th centuries as independent military base of the Russian Empire. Today Karosta is a special part of the city where the Tsarist time architecture coexists alongside with the Soviet era heritage.

During the Soviet time Karosta was a closed and covert zone with no admission even for the citizens of Liepaja. Karosta is a unique part of the city which occupies one third of Liepaja. It is a spectacular, paradoxical and unique site not only in Latvia but also in the world's history and architecture. Its environment reflects the interaction of tsarist Russia military elegance and Soviet militarism.



There are located several unique and popular sights in Karosta, such as the Northern breakwater, Manege, the Station of homing pigeons, the St. Nicholas Orthodox Maritime Cathedral, the Northern forts and Karosta Prison. Visitors have an opportunity to go on an excursion in the prison, to participate in a reality show "Behind the bars" or to stay overnight in a prison cell. Also visitors can watch a short film "Karosta" and dress up in military uniforms from different times and take photos.



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
